5	Evidence of maintenance The evidence to support personal savings of £1600 must be original on the official letter-headed paper or stationery of the organisation and have the official stamp of that organisation. It must have been issued by an authorised official of that organisation. Evidence must be in the form of cash funds. Other accounts or financial instruments such as shares, bonds, pension funds etc, regardless of notice period are not acceptable. If you wish to rely on a joint account as evidence of available funds, you must be named on the account along with one or more other named individual. All evidence must be dated no more than one month before the application is submitted.	
6	A certificate issued by International Organisation for Migration (IOM) confirming that the applicant is free from infectious tuberculosis (TB) Applies to all applicants aged 11 years and over	
7	All previous passports	
8	Visa fee

PLEASE NOTE:

1. *All specified documents must be original and where a document is not in English or Welsh, the original must be accompanied by a fully certified translation by a professional translator. This translation must include details of the translator's credentials and confirmation that it is an accurate translation of the original document, it must also be dated to include the original signature of the translator.*

We may want to verify the supporting documents an applicant sends with their application. Therefore applicant must ensure that all the evidence comes from a source that can be contacted and that we maybe able independently confirm the documents authenticity.

We aim to consider applications quickly. However, we must also be confident that applications meet the requirements of the UK Immigration Rules, and that the information an applicant provides is a true reflection of their background.

2. *An interview may be required at the Embassy or by phone*
3. *Application may need to be referred to the UK or other UK missions. This will inevitably cause delay in the processing time.*
