4	Thai identity card (<i>photocopy</i>)	
5	All previous passports	
6	Evidence of employment/ leave letter from Thai Company (<i>should state dates of approved leave and period of employment</i>) / letter from school (<i>should state dates of school holidays and applicant's course start and completion dates</i>); + evidence of your assets in Thailand (savings/ properties etc)	
7	Sponsored visits – If another person/a company is sponsoring your trip we must see the following documents- letter from the sponsor, a copy of their passport which include the biodata and all immigration record pages, their bank statements for the last 6 months or company registration and bank statements	
8	Sponsorship declaration, if treatment is to be paid for by anyone other than applicant themselves	
9	If you are paying for your trip, you will need to provide evidence of your finance, e.g. 6-month bank passbooks/ bank statements. (Original and a photocopy). Credit cards are not acceptable as evidence of available funds	
10	Referral letter from your local doctor	
11	A letter from a private doctor or hospital in the UK covering the nature of the applicant's medical condition, and the likely cost and duration of the medical treatment	
12	Visa fee	
13	<p>For travellers under the age of 18: A signed statement of consent from parent(s)/legal guardian(s) detailing your travel plans and the full names, passport numbers and contact details of up to two adults who will be travelling with you</p> <p>If you are travelling on your own, a signed statement to this effect from your parent(s)/legal guardian(s), detailing the arrangements made for your care in the UK and the full names and contact details of all adults involved in these arrangements</p>	
14	Any other documents in support of your application
